स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्र TOPOGRAPHICAL MAPS

* • भूमिका :- भारत में स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्रों का विकास 18 वीं सदी के मध्य में हुआ। स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्र बनाने का पहला प्रयास डी. वगविले ने किया। स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्र विभिन्न मापनियों पर मानचित्र रूखला के रूप में तैयार किए जाते हैं। भारतीय सर्वेक्षण विभाग भारत में, पूरे देश के लिए स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्र तैयार करता है।

* • स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्र का अर्थ :- स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्र समतल और झुं - गणितीय सर्वेक्षणों पर आधारित स्थले बहु - उद्देशीय मानचित्र होते हैं जिन्हें बहुत मापक पर बनाया जाता है। इन पर प्राकृतिक व विषय सांस्कृतिक विवरण, जिन्हें देखा जा सकता है; जैसे नगर, सड़कें, वनस्पति आदि।

- * • स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्रों की उपयोगिता एवं महत्व :-
1. यदि भूतल पर वितरित विभिन्न भौतिक एवं सांस्कृतिक स्वरूपों में पाए जाने वाले अंतरिक्षों का विश्लेषण और व्याख्या करनी हो तो स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्रों की खरिद और कोई साधन नहीं है।
 2. भौगोलिक अध्ययन के अतिरिक्त ये मानचित्र भौतिक गतिविधियों, प्रशासन, नियोजन, शोध, यात्रा तथा अन्वेषण के लिए उपयोगी हैं।
 3. स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्रों को सही मानचित्र भी कहते हैं।
 4. इन मानचित्रों पर इतनी ज्यादा जानकारी होती है कि इन्हें सूचनाओं का भण्डार भी कहते हैं।
 5. मानचित्र भूमि के चपे - चपे की जानकारी देते हैं।
 6. स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्र जानकारी देता है।

• चौथाई इंच प्रति मील शृंखला :-

जब किसी 4x4 इंच आकार का प्रत्येक मानचित्र 16 वर्ग इंच का क्षेत्र को दिखाएगा। आतः किसी प्रत्येक इंच की शृंखला में बाँटी जाती है।

• आधा इंच प्रति मील शृंखला :-

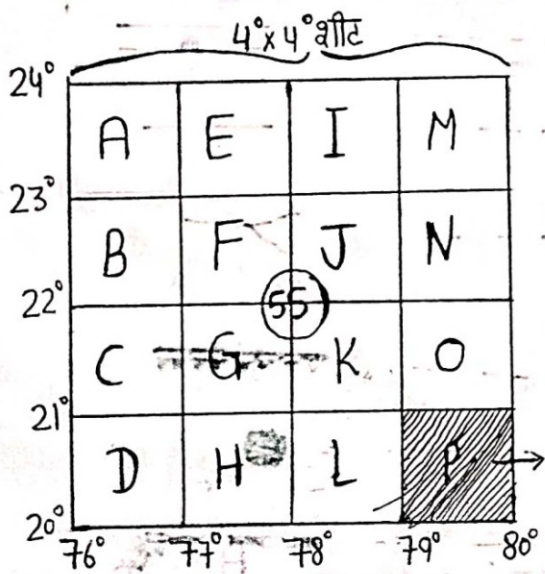
जब किसी चौथाई इंच की शृंखला या डिमी शीट का आकार भागों में बाँटी जाती है तब इनमें से प्रत्येक आधा डिमी शीट होगी, अर्थात् अक्षांशीय और देशान्तरिक विस्तार आधा डिमी या 30' होगा।

• एक इंच प्रति मील शृंखला :-

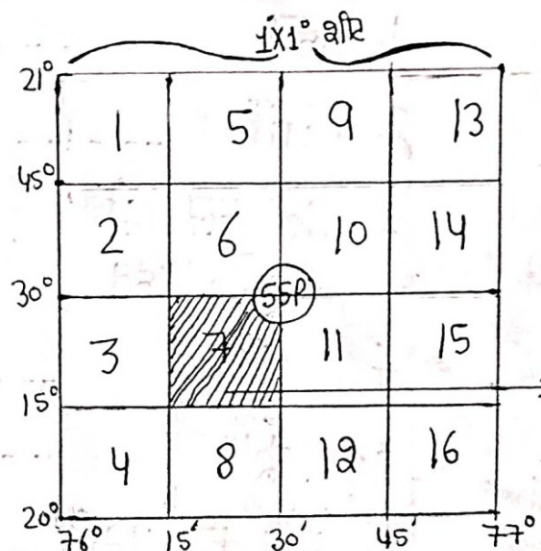
जब किसी चौथाई इंच या डिमी शीट का आकार भागों में बाँटी जाती है तब प्रत्येक मानचित्र का अक्षांशीय और देशान्तरिक विस्तार 16 इंच का क्षेत्र को 4 से 16 तक संख्याओं द्वारा अंकित किया जाता है।

• 1: 25,000 मापक की शृंखला :-

स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्रों की यह एक नई शृंखला है जिसमें एक इंच या चौथाई डिमी शीट या शीट का आकार भागों में बाँटा जाता है, इसका प्रत्येक भाग 5' अक्षांशीय तथा 7 1/2' देशान्तरिक विस्तार वाला होता है।

रूढ़ चिह्न एवं प्रतीक

परिभाषा :-

स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्रों पर विभिन्न शैतिक एवं सांस्कृतिक लक्षणों को जिन सर्वमान्य और परंपरागत चिह्नों, संकेतों व प्रतीकों की सहायता से प्रदर्शित किया जाता है, उसे रूढ़ चिह्न कहते हैं। इन रूढ़ चिह्नों की आकृतियों प्रदर्शित किए जाने वाले स्वरूपों से लगाया गਿਆ - जुलती है। आहरण की सुविधा के लिए प्रत्येक स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्र के दर्शनी हिस्से में नीचे की ओर रूढ़ चिह्नों की सूची दी गई होती है।

आवश्यकता एवं महत्व :-

रूढ़ चिह्नों का अर्थ समझी बिना स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्रों का अध्ययन और उसकी व्याख्या करना असंभव है।

2. रूढ़ चिह्नों की बनने के लिए आवश्यकता पड़ती है कि शुरू पर कुछ लक्षण इन्हें छूटे होते हैं कि उन्हें आपके के अनुसार स्थलाकृतिक मानचित्र पर प्रदर्शित नहीं किया जा सकता।

उच्चावच के निरूपण की विधियाँ

● क्षुण्णिका :-

उच्चावच का मानचित्र पृथ्वी गोलार्ध है और इसका अत्यंत ऊंचा - नीचा है, इसका कारण यह है कि उच्चावच अक्ष प्रक्षरित करित होता है, इसमें लम्बाई, चौड़ाई तथा ऊँचाई के तीनों विस्तार होते हैं, अर्थात् मानचित्र द्विविस्तारीय होता है। इसमें केवल लम्बाई, चौड़ाई के रूप होते हैं। उच्चावच का निरूपण मानचित्रकारों के लिए हमेशा एक चुनौती बना रहा है।

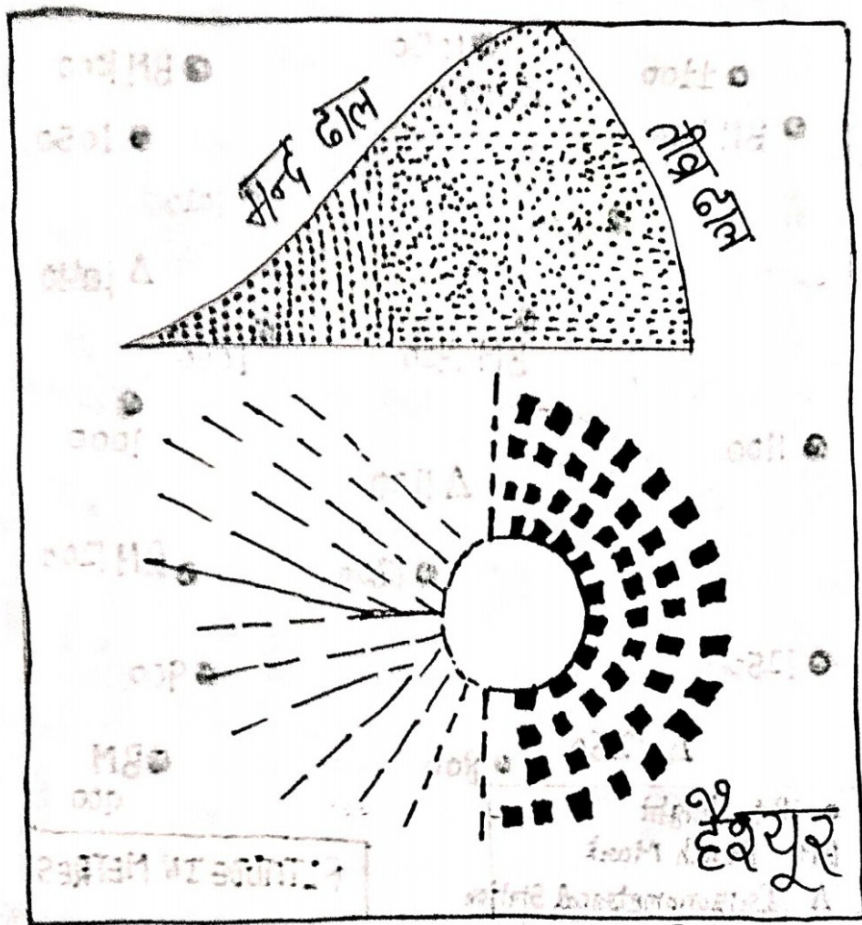

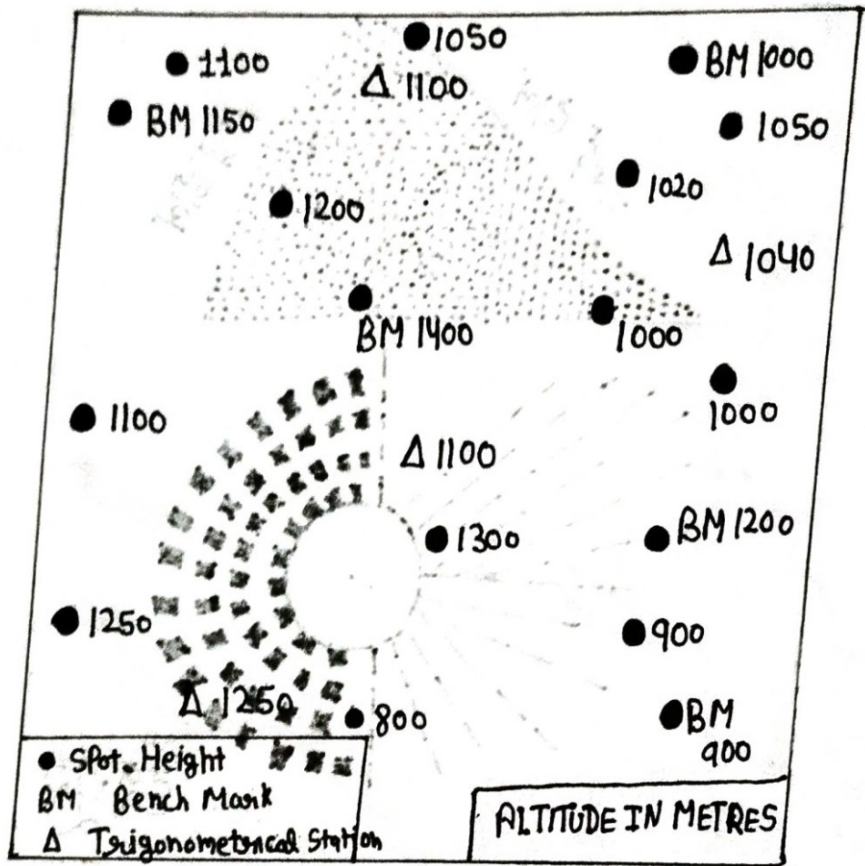
हैर्यूर (HACHURES)

उच्चारण निरूपण की इस प्रणाली का आविष्कार ऑस्ट्रिया के सैन्य अधिकारी जोहान्न जोर्ज लेहमान ने किया था, यह महीन व छोटी-छोटी रेखाएँ होती हैं जो डलान की दिशा में खींची जाती हैं। हैर्यूर अधिक सँ कम डलान की दिशा में अंगूँ दिखाई के लिए बनाई जाती हैं। इन्हें मानचित्र के सभी भागों में नहीं खींचा जाता। जहाँ लाल खड़ा होता है वहाँ यह रेखाएँ सीटी और पास-पास बनाई जाती हैं और जहाँ डलान मन्द होता है वहाँ ये रेखाएँ पतली और दूर-दूर बनाई जाती हैं। समतल भूमि को खाली छोड़ दिया जाता है। हैर्यूर घाटी तथा पठारों के शीर्ष जैसे समतल क्षेत्रों के लिए खींची जाते।

स्थानिक ऊँचाइयाँ

मानचित्र पर किसी स्थान विशेष की स्थिति एवं समुद्र - तल से उसकी ऊँचाई प्रदर्शित करने वाले बिन्दु को स्थानिक ऊँचाइयाँ कहते हैं। इन ऊँचाइयों को सर्वेक्षण द्वारा निर्धारित किया जाता है। इस विधि में मानचित्र में विभिन्न स्थानों की स्थिति गोल बिन्दुओं द्वारा दिखाकर उनकी समुद्र - तल से ऊँचाई मीटरों अथवा फुटों में लिख दी जाती है।

गुण :-

यह एक सरल विधि है जिसका प्रयोग अन्य विधियों के साथ किया जाता है।

दोष :-

इस विधि से किसी स्थान की समुद्र तल से ऊँचाई का तौ पता चलता है किन्तु उच्चावच का सही अनुमान नहीं लग पाता।

(ii) तल चिह्न :-

पर वास्तविक सर्वेक्षण के अंशों, पुलों तथा लोहे के खम्भों आदि से ऊँचाई प्रदर्शित करने वाले चिह्नो को तल चिह्न कहा जाता है। तल चिह्न की स्थिति को मानचित्र पर अक्षरों द्वारा दिखाया जाता है तथा इन अक्षरों के साथ उस चिह्न की ऊँचाई समुद्र तल से ऊँचाई लिख दी जाती है।

गुण :-

यह एक सरल विधि है।

दोष :-

इस विधि से भी केवल ऊँचाई का पता चलता है, उच्चावच का नहीं।

(iii) त्रिकोणमितीय सर्वेक्षण :-

यहाँ मानचित्र पर अंकित वे बिन्दु हैं जिनका धरातल पर त्रिभुज सर्वेक्षण करते समय प्रयोग किया गया था। मानचित्र पर इनकी स्थिति त्रिभुजों द्वारा दिखाकर समुद्र तल से इनकी ऊँचाई लिख दी जाती है।
