

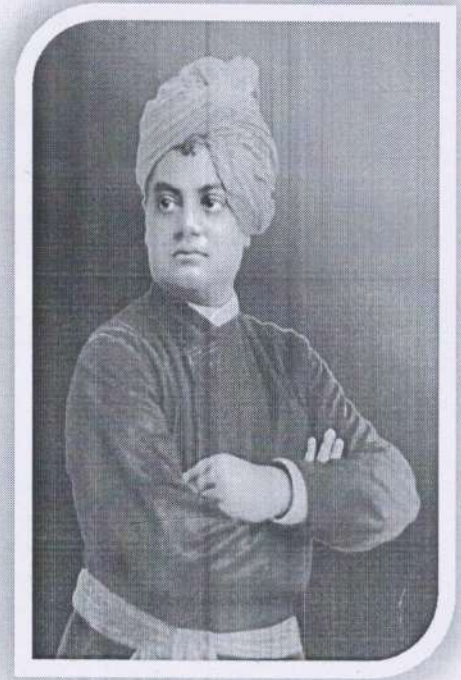

Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor Degree and /or in the Master's Degree or any other Qualification recognized as equivalent there to are eligible for admission to the programme.

Note:

- (i) There shall be no rounding off of percentage of marks of the qualifying examination from 0.5% and above to next higher number for determining the eligibility i.e. 49.5% and above will not be rounded off to 50%.
- (ii) 47.5% marks for SC/ST candidates of Haryana State only. As per letter dated :-16-07-2014
- (iii) 47.5% marks for Blind /Persons with Disabilities and visually/Hearing Impaired candidates.
- (iv) In case a candidate has passed the Master Degree Examination also after Bachelor Degree, the higher percentage of marks obtained in either of the two will be taken into consideration while preparing the merit
- (v) Compartmental candidates will not be allowed admission in B.Ed. (Regular Course) in any case.
- (vi) Cut off date for eligibility will be the last date/time of online choice filling.
- (vii) One year PG diploma in any subject will not be considered equivalent to Master's Degree.

However, if two or more candidates have obtained equal marks, following procedure will be used for the preparation of merit.

DIVISION OF SEATS

- a. The seats which remain vacant in Group-I i.e. Science & Arts with Maths-group can be converted in Group-II i.e. Arts & Commerce Group and vice-versa. Such vacant seats of one group will be converted into same category (General or Reserved) of the other group and if still these seats remain vacant only then these will be converted into General Category. In the event of quota reserved for Persons with Disabilities remain unutilized due to non availability for suitable category of Persons with disability, it may be offered to the Ex-servicemen and their wards (1%) and the dependents of Freedom Fighters (1%).

Further, 3% Horizontal reservation is also provided to Ex-servicemen/Freedom Fighters and their dependents by providing reservation within reservation of 1% of general category, 1% out of Scheduled Castes and 1% from backward classes' category for admissions to the various educational institutions of the Government and Government aided/institutes Located in Haryana. As far as block allocation in Block A and Block B of Backward Classes Impairment/Persons suffering from Locomotor Disability or Cerebral Palsy should be indicated clearly. For example, if Block A of Backward Classes are given seats in the Academic year 2014, the next Block i.e. B Block of category of Backward Classes will be given seats in the next academic year i.e. 2015 and so on. The Head of the Department concerned shall maintain the record for the purpose.

Note: A roaster for reservation of Ex-Serviceman/Freedom Fighter be maintained and carry forward all fractions till one seat is accumulated through different fractions over the years. 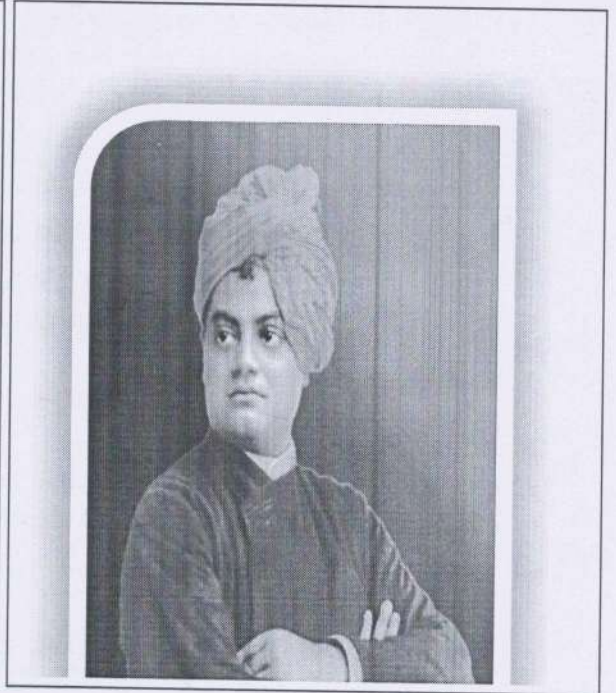

- (i) The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Competent Authority for EWS Income and Asset Certificate shall be Tehsildar of the area where the applicant normally resides.
- (ii) As per instructions given in Govt. of Haryana General Administration Dept. (G-III Branch) Notification No.22/12/2019-1GS-III dated 13.03.2019, Verifying Authorities for issue of EWS

Certificate shall be same as prescribed for issue of resident/income certificates as specified in instruction No. 22/28/2003-3GS-III, dated 30.01.2004.

(iii) The prescribed format for EWS Income and Asset Certificate shall be provided at Annexure-XVIII.

(b) Criteria of Income & Assets:

- (i) Persons who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for Scheduled Caste, Backward Classes (Block-A) and Backward Classes (Block-B) and whose family has gross annual income below Rs.6.00 lakh (Rupees six lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation, Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.
- (ii) Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:-
 - a) 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
 - b) Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
 - c) Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
 - d) Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities;
 - e) Total immovable assets owned are valued at Rs. One Crore of more.
- (iii) The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.
- (iv) The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who applies for benefit of reservation, his/her parents, spouse as well as children and siblings below the age of 18 years.

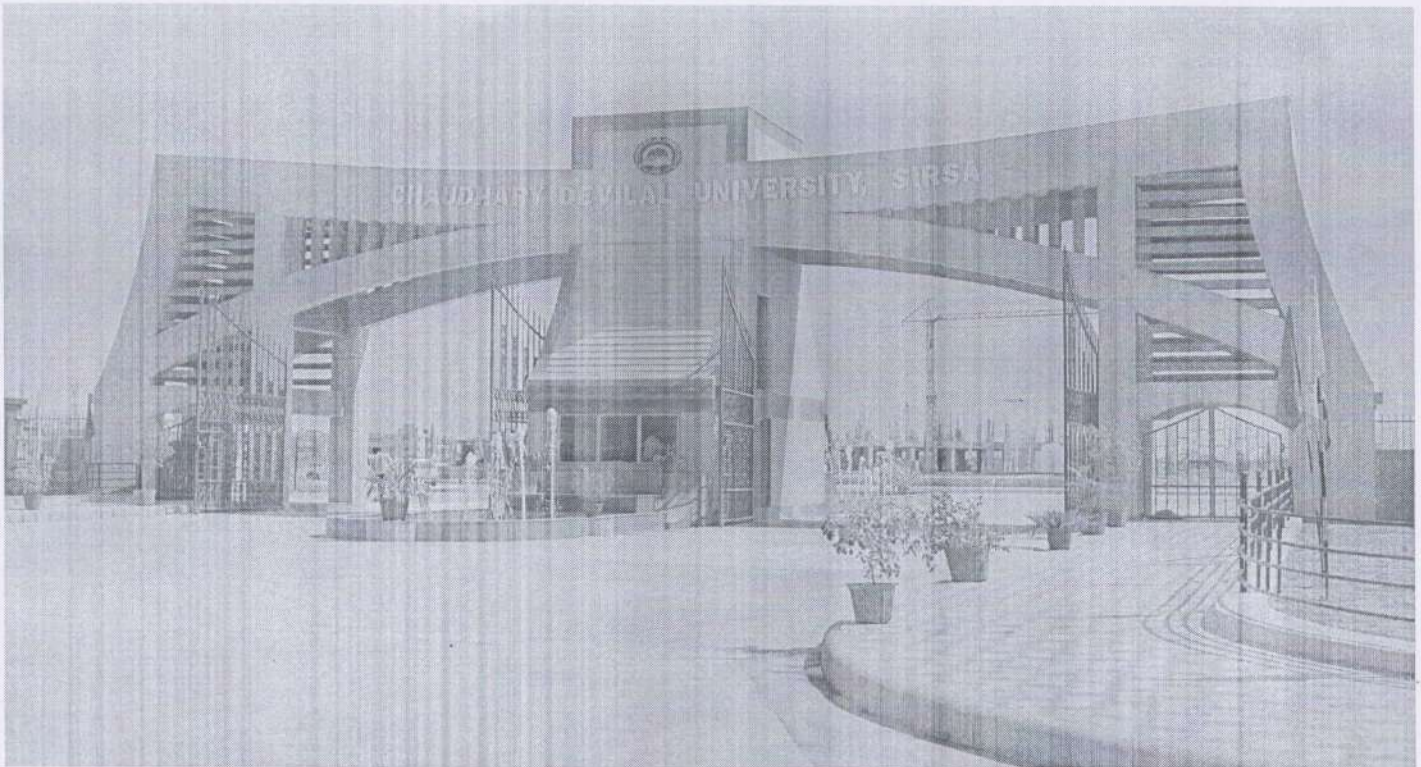

RESERVATION OF SEATS

1. Self Financing Colleges:

- (A) 15% of the total seats shall be open and will be filled on All India basis including Haryana.
(B) Remaining 85% seats are reserved for bona fide residents of Haryana.

2. Department of Education/Govt. Aided Colleges:

- (A) 15% of the total seats shall be open and will be filled on All India basis including Haryana.
(B) Remaining 85% seats are reserved for bona fide residents of Haryana and will be filled up as detailed below:

The seat matrix has been prepared on the basis of the reservation policy notified by the Govt. of Haryana vide Notification No. 22/10/2013 – IGSIII dated 28/2/2013 and 22/12/2019-IGS.III dated 25.02.2019, and instructions received from the State Govt. from time to time on the following basis:

a) All India Open Category Seats (Including Haryana State) (AIO)	15% of the sanctioned Intake
i) All India Open	90% of All India quota
ii) Economically Weaker Section (EWS) of All India quota.	10% of All India quota
b) State Quota	85% of the sanctioned Intake
i) Haryana Open General Open Category (HOGC)	40% of the State Quota
ii) Reserved category of Haryana	60% of the State Quota
iii) Scheduled Caste (SC)	20% of State quota (SC 10%, DSC 10%)
iv) Backward Classes of Haryana (A) (BCA)	16% of State quota
v) Backward Classes of Haryana (B) (BCB)	11% of State quota
vi) Economically Weaker Section (EWS)	10% of State quota
vii) Differently Abled Persons	3% of State quota

In the event of quota reserved for Physically Handicapped remain unfilled due to non availability for suitable category of Handicapped Candidates, it may be offered to the Ex-Servicemen and their wards (1%) and the dependents of Freedom Fighters (1%).

Further, 3% reservation is also provided to Ex-serviceman/ Freedom Fighter and their dependents by providing reservation within reservation of 1% of General Category, 1% out of Scheduled Caste and 1% from Backward Classes category for admission to the various educational institutions of the Govt. and Govt. aided / Institutes located in Haryana. As far as Block allocation in Block-A and Block-B of Backward Classes category is concerned year wise rotational system will be adopted. For example if Block-A of Backward Classes are given seats in academic year 2014, the next Block i.e. (B) Block of Category of Backward Classes will be given seats in the next academic year 2015 and so on. Further, a roster register for reservation of seats for ex- servicemen/freedom fighter shall be maintained and carry forward all fractions till one seat is accumulated through different fractions over the years. As and when the total comes to one seat will be provided. The Chairperson of the Department and Principal of the college concerned shall maintain the record for the purpose.

Definitions of Disabilities:

Definitions of categories of disabilities are given below:

- (I) (a) Blindness: "Blindness" refers to a condition where a person suffers from any of the following

conditions namely:-

- i) Total absence of sight; or
- ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (snellen chart) in the better eye with correcting lenses; or

- (i) Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degree or worse:

Low vision: 'Person with low vision' means a person with impairment of visual functioning even after treatment or standard refractive correction but who uses or is potentially capable of using vision for the planning or execution of a task with appropriate assistive device.

- (II) Hearing Impairment: "Hearing Impairment" means loss of sixty decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequencies.
- (III) (a) Locomotor disability: "Locomotor disability" means disability of the bones, joints or muscles leading to substantial restriction of the movement of the limbs or any form of cerebral palsy.
- (b) Cerebral Palsy: "Cerebral Palsy" means a group of non-progressive conditions of a person characterized by abnormal motor control posture resulting from brain insult or injuries occurring in the pre-natal, pre-natal or infant period of development.
- (c) All the cases of orthopedically handicapped persons would be covered under the category of "locomotor disability or cerebral palsy".

Guidelines for Reservation:

1. The Reservation of seats is as per the Reservation Policy of the Haryana Govt. and is subject to any change/amendment by the State govt. from time to time.
2. In case seats of DSC remains vacant, the same will be filled up from the SC candidates and vice versa. Similarly, if the reserved seat(s) of BC Block 'A' remain vacant these will be filled up from BC Block 'B' and vice versa. Further, if the reserved seats of EWS category remains vacant, then these will be filled up from HOGC/AI open as the case may be.
3. If a candidate of Haryana General, SC and BC also applies for Differently Abled/ESM/DFP category, he/she will be considered first for Haryana General, SC and BC category.
4. If the quota reserved for Differently Abled Persons candidates remains vacant due to non-availability of candidates, these seats will be given to ESM and their wards, dependents of Freedom Fighters and wards of Military Personnel who died in operation 'Vijay' on the basis of their merit.
5. In case the number of applications is/falls less than the number of sanctioned seats in any Programme, the vacant seats under reserved categories except SC will be filled as follows:
 - I. The seats remaining vacant in any other Reserved Category shall be filled from Haryana Open category, if the candidate belonging to the respective category is not available at the time of physical presence.
 - II. Further, in case, the seats remain vacant in Haryana Open category, the same will also be thrown open to All India Open category.
 - III. In case the number of applications received in any category is less than the number of sanctioned seats, all the vacant seats will be thrown open to as per the above two clauses.
 - IV. **No SC/DSC seat will be converted into General category.**
 - V. Roster System will not be maintained in case of admissions as per Haryana Govt. instructions.
 - VI. Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Caste, Backward Class (Block 'A' & 'B') and EWS (**Govt. notification and certificate available at www.cdlu.ac.in**) categories will submit the certificate as per **Annexure-V, VII** and affidavit as per **Annexure-IX** regarding income proof to decide creamy layer category, **Annexure-VI**, respectively.
6. Certificate from ward of Deceased/Disabled/Discharged Military/Para-Military personnel/Ex

Servicemen or Ex-Personnel of Para-Military Forces – **Annexure-VIII** must be enclosed with the admission form for taking the benefit of reservation.

The seats reserved for ESM category shall be offered in order of following priorities:

- a) Wards of Ex-servicemen died in action while in active service.
 - b) Ex-serviceman himself.
 - c) Wards of Ex-servicemen.
 - d) Wards of Paramilitary Forces.
7. Only the candidates having permanent disability of not less than 40% (being otherwise fit for admission to the Programme(s)) will be considered for admission as Differently Abled. Disability certificate must be issued by the Chief Medical Officer of the concerned District. The Admission Committee can recommend for verification in case of any doubt to the concerned Chief Medical Officer. Differently abled candidates belonging to Haryana are required to submit the certificate as per **Annexure-IX**.

- (c) All the cases of orthopedically handicapped persons would be covered under the category of "locomotor disability or cerebral palsy".
